Infant/child sleep expert Kim West, widely known as The Sleep Lady®, says the maternal pulse and blood flow as heard by a baby before it's born is much more likely to be soothing than that of a fetal heartbeat as heard from a ultrasound, which is unfamiliar to a newborn's ears.

The Maternal Whispers CD is 72-minutes long and can be looped by setting a CD player to "repeat" to keep a baby company throughout the night.
